

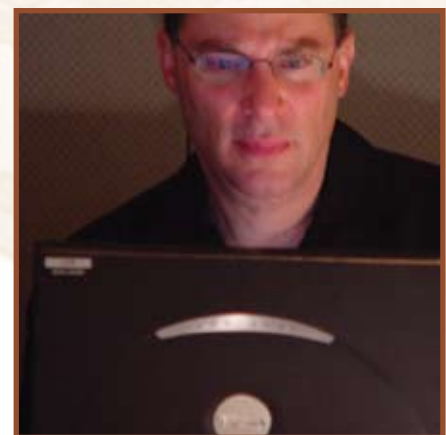

How long does it take to sell a lot once the auctioneer calls for the opening bid? The average lot in a live coin auction sells in less than twenty seconds. Floor bidders need to be prepared to act quickly, and make instantaneous decisions. But now, Heritage's Internet leadership has changed the entire bidding dynamic. Heritage maximizes the number of participants, and the amount they bid, through our exclusive *Interactive Internet™* bidding system, which creates a virtual auction room floor lasting weeks prior to every live auction. It takes Heritage three weeks to "hammer down" your Signature coins and currency, giving our bidders weeks to generate millions of dollars in successful bids from around the globe, pushing prices higher and higher.

When interested Internet bidders view a lot, they see the current high bid and are prompted for a higher bid; upon entering a bid, they receive immediate notification on the screen if their bid was successful. If they topped the previous high bid, they are now the leader; if all they did was increase the current bid to a level still below the leader's bid, they are immediately prompted again and again to bid higher. If they are the new leader, the old leader receives an email notifying them that their prior bid has now been topped, and provides them an easy link for immediately raising their bid.

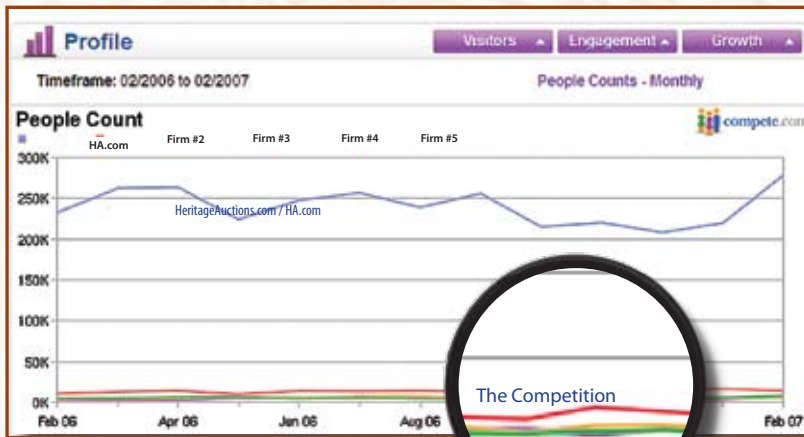
